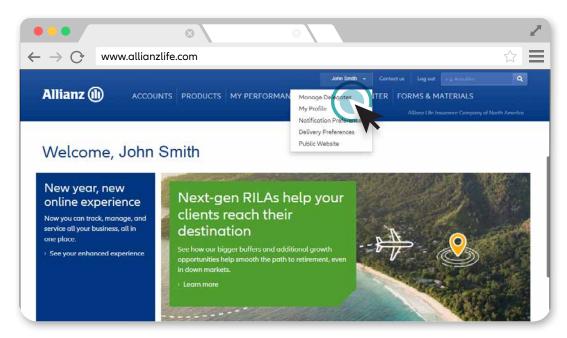


Delegate access guide

Please watch this <u>instructional video</u> and refer to these screen shots for step-by-step instructions.

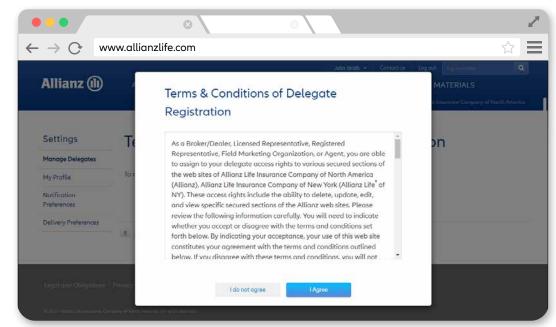


From the home screen on the Allianz secured website, navigate to your name in the upper blue banner to the left of **Contact us** and click on the down arrow and select **Manage Delegates.**





Read and agree to the Terms & Conditions of Delegate Registration.



Product and feature availability may vary by state and broker/dealer.



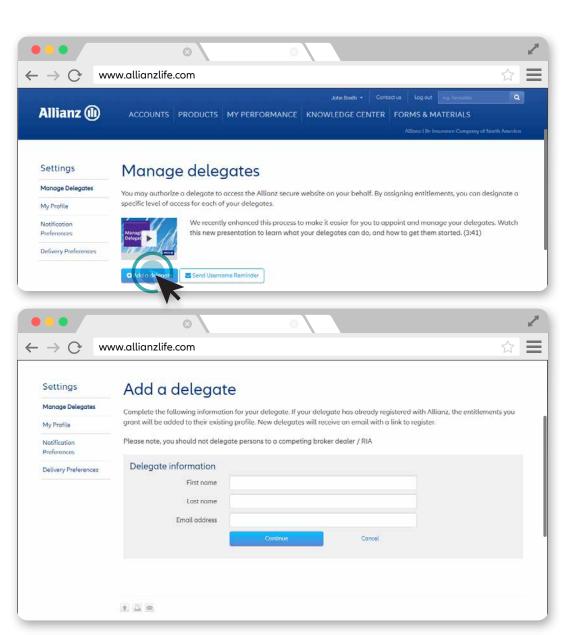
From the Manage delegates page, select +Add a delegate highlighted in blue.

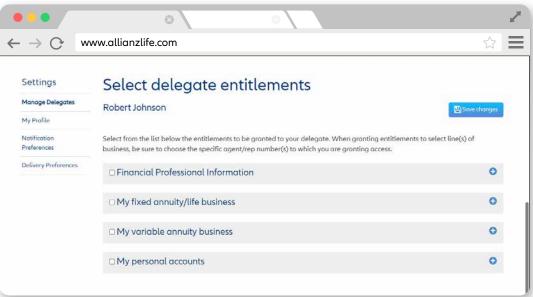


From the Add a delegate page, complete the fields with your delegate's first name, last name, and email address. If your delegate has already registered with Allianz, the entitlements you grant will be added to their existing profile. If your delegate is new, they will receive an email with a link to register.



From the Select delegate entitlements page, select the entitlement to be granted to your delegate. If you are granting entitlements to select lines of business, be sure to choose the specific agent/rep number(s) you are granting access to.

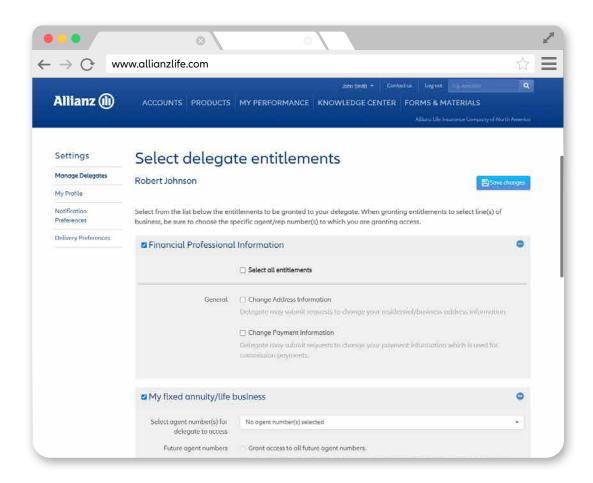




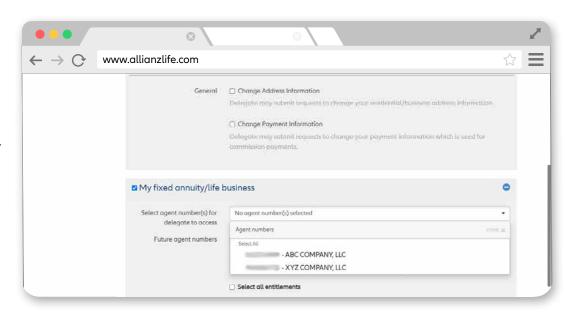

Once you select your delegate entitlements, additional fields will display so you can customize your delegate's entitlements/access.

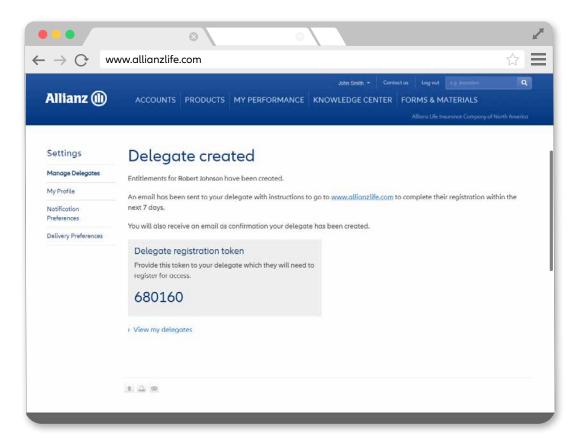


If you select a specific line of business to grant delegate access to, you will be prompted to select from a dropdown the specific agent/rep number you are granting delegate access to.

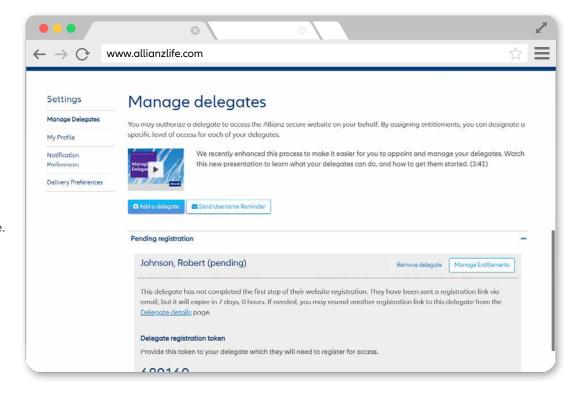




Once you have selected entitlements, your delegate and their entitlements will be created. Your delegate will receive an email directing them to www.allianzlife.com to complete their registration within the next seven days. You will receive an email confirmation that your delegate has been created. You will also receive a delegate registration token code that you must provide to your delegate, as they will need the token code to register for access.



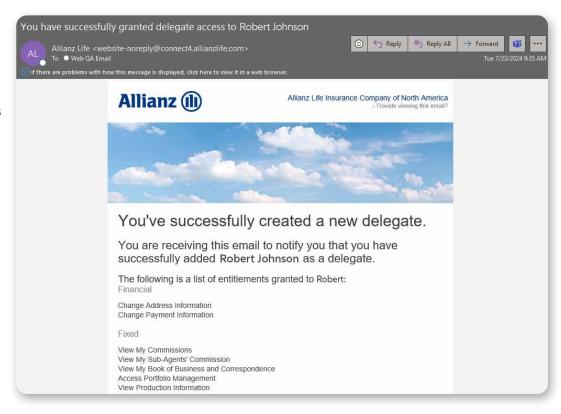
In this step you can elect to watch a short video on managing delegates. In addition, this is where you will see your pending delegates and the token code you will need to provide to your delegate. You can also resend the registration link, remove delegates, and/or manage entitlements from this page.



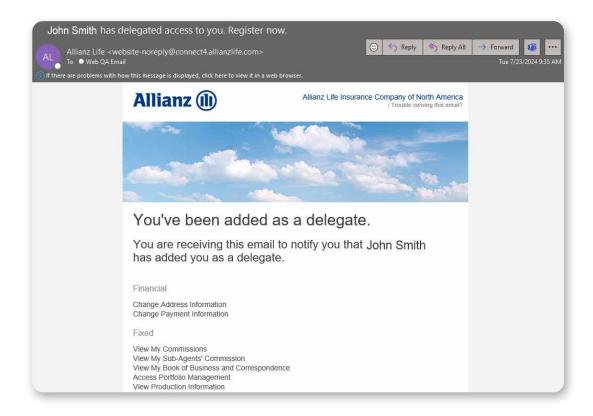

You will receive an email once you've successfully created a new delegate. This email will include the name of your delegate and the entitlements you granted.

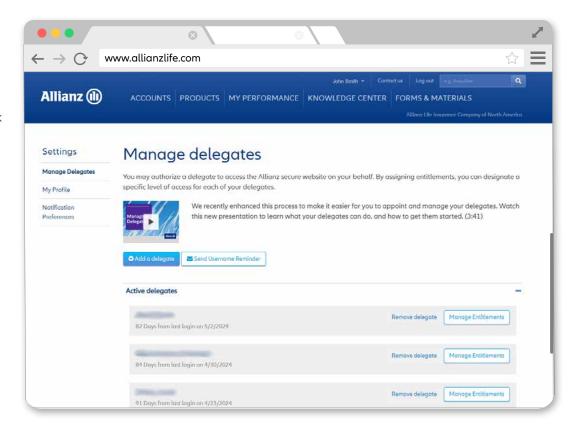


Your delegate will receive an email confirming that they have been added as a delegate and the entitlements they have been granted.





In order to manage your delegates and their entitlements, navigate back to the home page on the secure Allianz website and select the down arrow next to your name to the left of Contact us and select Manage delegates. From this screen you can watch the managing delegates video, add new delegates, remove existing delegates, and/or manage your delegates' entitlements.



Agencies, FMOs, and AFMOs will register using the principal individual's information:

- If a financial professional is contracted through an agency and they are contracted as the principal of that agency, the producer will register for website access as normal using the agent's name, date of birth, and SSN. Registration will recognize that the individual is also the principal of the agency, and agency information will automatically be attached to the producer's login.
- Similarly, an FMO or AFMO is contracted with an individual listed as the principal for the entity. To set up website
 access, the principal would register as normal using the principal's name, date of birth, and SSN. Registration will
 recognize that they are the principal of the FMO or AFMO, and access is created accordingly.

Additional information:

- Trustee must call in to 800-950-1962 to request registration to their trust-owned policies. Once registered, the Trustee will access their trust-owned policies, associated with the trust TIN via Manage Delegates.
- Clients, Agents, FMO, AFMOs, and B/Ds have the ability to create delegate access.
- There are certain ownership types that cannot register or have access to Allianzlife.com for example: KaiZen,
 Foreign National policies (due to no SSN), Beneficiaries, or Power of Attorney. Some LLC- or corporation-owned
 policies may have access; however, this is reviewed/approved on a case-by-case basis.
